- 3. Submits a concise, typed 1-page summary (no smaller than size 12 font) that discusses
 - a. Achievements, academic or other
 - b. Awards, academic or other
 - c. Intended Major and intended college/university/trade school
 - d. Clearly-defined career goals after education is completed
 - e. Volunteer work beyond high school/religious obligations, etc.
 - f. Any other pertinent information
- 4. Includes 2 letters of recommendation from instructors whose coursework has been taken during the last 3 years of high school
- 5. Provides a recent photo (may be a good quality photocopy)
- 6. Meets submission deadline, received by the Scholarship Chair, no later than 5 pm, April 3, 2020.

The SCRA Interview Committee uses a scoring system based on promptness and completeness of the application form with necessary documentation and references, and on final responses to the interviewers' questions.

The cash awards will be awarded at one of our weekly Tour Meetings, date to be assigned (usually early June).

Please make the attached scholarship application available to those seniors who qualify. Thank you for your cooperation and assistance. We look forward to participating in your scholarship awards program!
